INnovations in plant Varlety Testing in Europe



Fostering the introduction of new varieties better adapted to varying biotic and abiotic conditions and to more sustainable crop management practices.

- INVITE explores opportunities to improve the current variety testing system (including official DUS & VCU testing and post-release performance testing), e.g. by use of advanced phenotyping, genotyping or modelling tools, and to assess sustainability profile of varieties allowing more sustainable cropping systems.
- The project experiments on major crop species that represent the main features of propagation, food and feed uses, and exhibit significant breeding activity in the EU.
- INVITE aims to provide information to stakeholders on variety performance under a wide range of production conditions and their sustainability profile.
